Junior Volunteer Programs

Springhill Medical Center Teenage Volunteers

- Ages 14-17
- Application period begins January through March
- Program runs June through third week of July
- Four hours per week in 15 different service areas

Contact the Director of Volunteer Services at 251-460-5223 during the application period.

The Director will contact applicants for personal interviews. Once accepted based on applications, interviews and recommendations, volunteers must purchase a uniform, have a TB test and complete two mandatory orientations.

Thomas Hospital Auxiliary Junior Volunteer Program

- Ages 14-17
- Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- Applications are available in February and due in April
- Orientation process - TB test, drug and alcohol screening and orientation class - conducted in May
- Four hours a week for six weeks in June and July, with the opportunity to continue during the school year

North Baldwin Infirmary Junior Volunteer

- Must be at least 14 years of age
- Complete application
- Complete health assessment
- Two recommendations from teacher, principal, guidance counselor, minister, manager of a business that knows your work ethic
- Copy of driver's license, school ID card.
- Proof of immunizations
- Attend required orientation
- Four hours a week for three months
- Can work during the year after school as well as the summer months (3:30 - 5:30 p.m.)
